SHARK KILLS JERSEY BATHER

Attacks Philadelphia Man in Surf. at Beach Haven.

Beach Haven, N. J., July 3.—Charles Etting Van Sant, twenty three, son of Dr. E. L. Van Sant of Philadelphia, was billed by a shark here.

Leaving several companions, Van Sant swam out beyond the combers. As he was coming about to the shore onlookers from the beach and boardwalk were horrified to see the dorsal fin of a nine foot shark while it was 300 yards away. The cry of "Danger!" was carried to Van Sant by the life guards, who went to his assistance. Then began the race for life. Van Sant lost. The shark attacked him before being frightened away. He was taken to the Engleside hospital, where he died.
